 - a. Will donate to certain organizations and north by fire victims

VII. Fundraising

- a. Boosterthon
 - i. Spends 160-170 hours on our campus
 - ii. Total pledge \$68300
 - 1. We keep 57%, \$38837
 - a. \$1187 still outstanding
 - 2. This is more than \$10000 than we have ever profited
 - iii. Shirts were sponsored by local businesses
 - 1. \$1000 was made profit from shirts as well
 - iv. Character Program was well thought out and presented
 - 1. We have spent \$7000 in the past on this type of program alone

VIII. Special Funding Requests

- a. \$161700 is our YTD income
- b. Approximately \$7000 is not currently allotted
- c. Carpet for second music teacher's classroom
 - i. \$800 is being requested
 - ii. Went back to him with a couple other options that were less expensive
 - 1. \$371.41 for a similar square rug (7x10)
 - 2. \$400.00 for a common core rug (30 squares)
 - iii. Robin Wilhite motions to approve the spending for the rug
 - iv. Angela Marotta seconds motion
 - v. All in favor
 - vi. Motion passes
- d. All purpose teaching easel
 - i. \$266.42 is being requested
 - ii. This is good for younger children on the carpet
 - iii. There are also a lot of new teachers that could possibly request this

- iv. This would be an asset for the school not property of the teacher
- v. Robin Wilhite motions to approve the spending for the easel
- vi. Sushmitha Sudini seconds motion
- vii. 10 in favor
- viii. 2 abstain
- ix. Motion passes

e. Picnic Tables

- i. 6 were purchased last year
 - 1. This is not quite enough for upper grades
- ii. 4 lunch periods are being run here
 - 1. There is not enough staff to clean all indoor tables for each lunch period
- iii. \$4600 would be the cost for the requested 4 more tables
- iv. Could possibly do 2 now and 2 later
- v. Would also possibly need umbrellas to shade some tables
- vi. We need to investigate cost and layout further
 - 1. This will be revisited at January meeting as weather will not permit outdoor eating at this time

IX. Cottonwood

- a. Sobia Qureshi requests that we consider what monies we can give to Cottonwood to start PFC
- b. In April we will have a better idea of how many Amador students will be going to Cottonwood
 - i. Kolb gave \$10000 for approximately 300 students
